**Nursery intended learning:**

*Recapping the learning from Term 1 for new starters*

- To understand where we are / live in the immediate surroundings
- To develop interests in things from the past and present day

**Key Vocabulary**

- Places where we live – Botley, Oxford, street names etc.
- Family names (Grandad, step-mum, Aunty uncle etc)
- Different names of homes (flat, apartment, caravan, etc)
- Features of our world – moon, Earth, stars etc.

**Key questions:**

- Where do I like?
- Where have I visited?

**Core texts**

- My friends and me
- Errol's garden
- Whatever next!

**Other Texts (recapping from previously taught themes)**

- Non-Fiction books related to topic

**Literacy / CL**

- Retelling stories and begin to use story language and vocabulary
- Creating own journeys linked to imaginative play

**Cultural Capital and Enrichment activities**

- Walking around the school grounds
- Having a teddy bear's picnic

**Key people of focus**

**PSED**

- Transition into Nursery for the new children (similar to the first few weeks of the Autumn Term) – learning routines, rules etc

**UW**

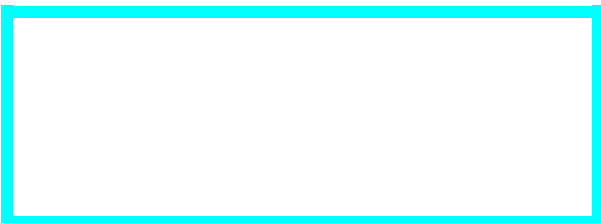
- Exploring darkness, moon, stars linked to 'Whatever Next!'

**EAD**

- 3D collage of moon / rockets
- Chinese New Year – making lion head, dancing
- Creating own imaginative stories about journeys, families and going to the moon.
- Use loose parts (large resources) for imaginative journeys e.g. crates, tubing, boxes
- Drawing maps
- Making aliens
