

# Botley School

Dear Parents/Carers,

What a busy half term this has been, and the last two weeks have been particularly busy for our staff and students, so apologies for the lack of newsletter last week. Last week Year 3 had a wonderful time going on a bug hunt in the quad and making use of our newly arrived reading nook, as well as the story telling chair.



We also had visitors from the NSPCC in school to talk to the children about their 'Speak Out, Stay Safe' campaign. The children all watched online age-appropriate assemblies on the 9<sup>th</sup> October. This was followed up by a workshop for year 2 pupils and a workshop for year 5 and 6 pupils in school on the 14<sup>th</sup> during which they were introduced to 'Buddy' the mascot for the campaign. The volunteers were impressed with how responsive and articulate our pupils are as well as how much knowledge the pupils had about keeping themselves safe.



Our Running club pupils took part in the Oxford School's Challenge on the 12<sup>th</sup> as well. The pupils and staff all arrived early and full of enthusiasm. The pupils ran brilliantly and were rightly and incredibly proud of their achievements and receiving their medals.



Yesterday as part of the RE curriculum and learning about festivals and traditions, we had a visit from Rabbi Zvi who spoke to our pupils in assembly and led workshops in year 1 and in year 2 about the celebration of Succot which this year fell between the 6<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> October. He spoke about the importance building Succot hut and the Scent Fruit, and the similarities of this to our harvest festival and the values of community and teamwork.



For members of our community celebrating Succot or Diwali, which also took place this week, I hope you had a peaceful and wonderful festival period.

Today our year 5 pupils had a fantastic trip to Pembroke College and the Bodleian Library as part of their unit of work on the history of Oxford. Thank you to Mr Bonsaver for enabling this trip to happen again this year. I understand the pupils had a wonderful day.



Finally, next term, our first week back will be our poetry week. Over half term we have provided pupils with a selection of poems to read. We would like every child to choose the poem they like best, or a poem of their own choosing, to perform in our school **Poetry Slam Competition**. With a focus on presentational and recital skills, each class will hold heats during the week, with the best poetry performers being asked to recite their poem in the assembly on Friday afternoon. I can't wait to hear their fantastic efforts and am already looking forward to returning after the break!

## Year 6 parents: Apply now for their secondary school place:

The application portal is now open for families of Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school place for September 2026.

We strongly encourage families to apply online via the following link: [Year 7 - secondary school applications | Oxfordshire County Council](#)

If online applications are not possible, forms can be printed from the school office or completed digitally.

### Key Dates:

The portal opened on 12 September 2025 and will close on **31 October 2025** (deadline for **on-time applications**).

Reminder for parents of the following important points:

- **Apply on Time**  
Late applications will not receive an offer on National Offer Day (**2 March 2026**) and may reduce the chance of securing a place at a preferred school.
- **Address Updates**  
If families have recently moved or are planning to move, they must upload proof of address (e.g. tenancy agreement, Council Tax bill, or exchange of contracts) alongside their application. They should also inform their child's current primary school to avoid discrepancies in the system.
- **Sibling Information**  
Parents should include details of any siblings already attending the schools they are applying to.
- **List Multiple Preferences**  
Encourage families to list more than one school preference (up to four can be selected).
