Dear Parents/Carers,

On Tuesday, Lilac Class welcomed representatives from the Environment Agency for an engaging workshop on local flood prevention. Students learned about the measures being taken to reduce flooding in the area and then worked in groups to design their own flood defences, considering the needs of animals, river users, recreation, and the wider community. They also explored the dangers associated with flooding and discussed what to do in an emergency. A highlight was when some brave volunteers reached into water to retrieve hidden hazards. It was an enjoyable and informative session that deepened the children's understanding of flood safety.



On Thursday, for World Book Day, the children came dressed as a host of different characters from their favourite books. We had a lovely time filled with celebrating our love of books, reading and celebrating our favourite authors. KS2 did a host of activities, including an online World Book Day lesson with the BBC, completing a book review of their favourite story, and presenting their outfits and chosen book to their class. There was also a Book Swap, where children exchanged an old book for a golden ticket, which they then swapped for a new book

Reception and KS1 also had a visit from an author, Jason Brown. He read his book 'Carl Loft and the Oover Monster' and talked about how he created the monsters. Jason Brown is a children's author and illustrator based in the Oxfordshire area. His love of science fiction, fantasy and cryptozoology has inspired both his written and illustrated work. His self-published children's book, 'Carl Loft and the Oover Monster', was a successfully funded Kickstarter project and a revised, second edition of his book is now available in a selection of local independent book shops in and around Oxford. Carl Loft and the Oover Monster is a humorous story aimed at 5-7 year olds that deals with a small child's fear of inanimate objects. To help him solve this problem the title character employs the services of real monsters (as you do) from around his home and surrounding area, to help him scare away the most terrifying of all inanimate horrors, his mother's villainous vacuum cleaner, the Oover Monster! The moral of the story is Carl's discovery that fear is all in the mind, and that he is not as scared as he first thought. The children thoroughly enjoyed the story and the discussions about monsters!



In a couple of weeks, we have our first Rock Steady show case with our budding rock bands performing in the school hall at 2:30 on Friday 20th March. The event is open to parents of pupils performing, and any other parents interested in finding out more about how Rock Steady works in school. We look forward to rocking out with you then!

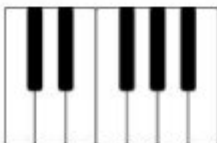


