**Near miss outside school**

Recently there was a near miss, when a car reversed onto the pavement while attempting a 3-point turn. One of our youngest students was walking to school with his parent and was very close to being hit by the car as the driver clearly couldn't see them. This could have been a very serious incident had the child and parent not reacted in time to avoid being hurt. No child should ever have to be worried about being hit by a car when they are walking on the pavement to school. In order to keep our pupils safe, can I remind parents again, that the parking on Elms road is for residents only. If you have to drive to school, please park at the Elms Parade shops and walk the remaining distance. It is not safe to park and then attempt manoeuvres in such a narrow road where there are small children walking.
