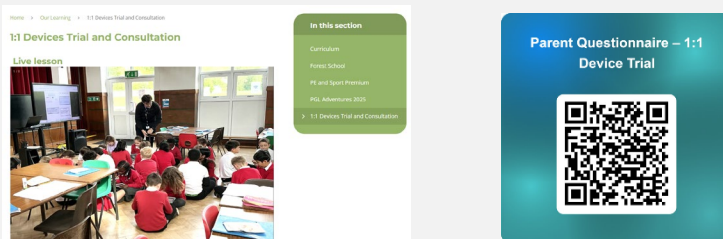
Congratulations to year 6 who showed all their resilience and determination in the SATs last week. This week, the rest of the school will be completing their summer term assessments, and I am sure they will show just as much resilience as the year 6 pupils.

On Monday the Reception and KS1 children were treated to a Stagecoach session. The children were introduced to some Stagecoach games including 'Charlie swan over the ocean' which was similar to 'Duck, Duck, Goose'. The children learnt a dance routine and were very quick at learning the actions and moves. We ended the session with a 'Freeze frame' where the children put their acting skills into practice to create a snapshot photo. The children brought a flyer home with details of sessions run locally.


