Dear Parents/Carers,

As many of you will already be aware, Botley School have been planning to extend our SEND provision with a resource base for pupils with autism spectrum conditions/communication and interaction disorders. We are delighted that the local authority is supporting our plans and therefore, as required by law, we are formally consulting to open a resource base at Botley School from as early as January 2027. As a truly inclusive school, we have already seen the transformative benefits of opening our enhanced provision classes at Botley. Because of the provision, our pupils' needs are met, they are able to learn and make progress from their starting points, and the school is a happy and positive learning environment for all. We wish to extend this provision, building on our excellence with the enhanced pathway and ensure we can offer an inclusive school to a wider section of our community.

Next week is our pupil well-being focus week. We specifically chose this time as we also have our mid-year assessment week which can be a source of worry for some of our children. To start the focus week, today we were visited by Blessin and Jennifer from the Mental Health Team who gave an assembly to KS1 and then to KS2. They talked about what mental health and wellbeing means, what signs to look out for that show you might be worried or need to speak to someone, and who to go to for support.

This week year 1 and year 3 had a visit from PCSO Sue Haynes. The year 1 class got to hear the story of PC Ben and how he helps people, read to them virtually by the author himself! Year 3 got to hear the story of 'The Clown Who Took Flight' which helped them think about how people are the same and different, but that we all need to be respected and show respect to others.



In an incredibly busy week, our year 5 class have been have an amazing time working on drama skills and playwriting with the ever-brilliant team from Primary Playmaker. One lucky group will have their play chosen to be performed by actors at the theatre later this term.



Finally, this week our first rock bands have started their lessons with our band leader Christopher. There are still places available so if your child expresses an interest. If you have any questions or wish to discuss the cost of lessons, please do speak to me next week.

1. STOP AND THINK

Keep back from slippery banks and wear footwear with a good grip. Stick to well-lit areas and plan your walks in daylight or along well-lit paths. Never go onto the ice.



3. CALL 999

Call 999 – do not enter cold water or ice to rescue. Try and reach them from the bank.



2. STAY TOGETHER

Keep children within reach and teach children not to go onto ice. Keep dogs on a lead. Walk with friends.



4. FLOAT


Stay calm, float on your back and call for help. Throw something that floats to somebody that has fallen in. If you cannot climb out, wait for help and keep as still as possible. Preserve heat by pressing your arms by your side and keep your legs together. Keep your head clear of the water.



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
